

— WEEE STATEMENT

WEEE DIRECTIVE 2012/19/EU

Electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) contains materials, components and substances that may be hazardous. This can present a risk to human health and the environment when this waste is not handled correctly.

Equipment marked with the crossed-out wheeled bin is electrical and electronic equipment. The crossed-out wheeled bin symbol indicates that waste electrical and electronic equipment should not be discarded together with unseparated municipal waste, but must be collected separately.

As user, you have an important role in recycling this equipment and contributing to the protection of the environment. Users are responsible for removing personal data from electronic devices prior to disposal.
