#### Additional Information

No tests were conducted under this investigation based on testing previously conducted under CBTR Ref. No. E139109-A171-CB, CB Test Certificate Ref. No. US-30103-UL to IEC 60950-1:2005 (Second Edition), Am1:2009 + Am2:2013. All required tests were carried out under the previous investigation except where specifically noted. Based on the results of previous evaluation, and a current review of the product construction, it was determined that the products comply with the standard.

The CB Test Report E139109-A6038-CB-1 serves as CRD for CAN/CSA C22.2 No. 62368-1.

The nameplate markings provided are considered representative of the entire series and only the output ratings may vary.

The need for the additional testing and evaluation shall be determined in the end product investigation.
